ABOUT THIS PIECE

"At the Hour of Closing" is a setting of a poem by 11th-century Sephardic rabbi Moshe ibn Ezra, sung here in stunning English translation by Peter Cole and set for SATB choir, string quartet, and mezzo-soprano soloist. The text speaks of a community in exile returning home at the last with justice and joy. When setting this piece, I gave the italicized portions of the poem to the choir, and the unitalicized text to the mezzo-soprano soloist, for a responsory effect. With influences from a wide variety of musical sources, this piece captures the agony and ecstasy of finally returning to one's homeland.

Lord of wondrous workings, grant us understanding—now at the hour of closing.

A chosen few are called, their eyes toward you lifting—they stand exalted in their trembling now, at the hour of closing.

They pour forth their souls; erase, then, their straying—and grant them, Lord, your absolution now at the hour of closing.

Be a shelter for them through all their suffering; consign them only to rejoicing now, at the hour of closing.

Show them your compassion, in your justice turning on all who brought oppression to them—

now at the hour of closing.

Recall their fathers' merit and count it as merit for them; renew their days as once they were, now, at the hour of closing.

Call for the year of grace—the remnant flock's returning to Oholibah and Oholih—now at the hour of closing.

Katie Kring is a choral composer, writer-of-musicals, and baker based in Springfield, MO.



Katie is aa prolific choral composer and a passionate advocate for writing good parts for altos. Her piece "The Snow is Deep on the Ground," (text by Kenneth Patchen), was published by Walton Music in 2015, and is now performed internationally. Katie has been commissioned to write numerous works, including "Dreams" and "I See You" (April 2019) for the Springfield Chamber Chorus, where she has served as Composer-In-Residence.

In 2015, she was commissioned by St. John's Episcopal Church in Springfield, MO to create a new choral setting of the sung Compline service for men's choir. Gerrit Scheepers' Brooklyn Choral Artists commissioned her compositions "At the Hour of Closing" and "Land of Rest" which premiered in Pretoria, South Africa in September 2018.

Katie's musical theatre works include PEARL (Goodspeed Musicals, CT, 2007), ONWARD (with J. Oconer Navarro, 59E59, New York City, 2009), FARMERS MARKET THE MUSICAL (with Rob Hartmann, Fairmont, WV, 2013), IN THE SWIM and THINK BIG (with Rob Hartmann, Monterey Bay Aquarium, CA, 2013 & 2014), and KELLY THE DESTROYER VS THE SPRINGFIELD COBRAS (with Rob Hartmann, Spokane, WA, 2015 and Springfield, MO, 2019).

Katie is also the owner of B+B Boulangerie & Bakery and Lead Instructor of KatieMade Baking & Cooking School. She received her MFA in Musical Theatre Writing at NYU and her BFA in music at the University of Michigan.
